PROMPT: How do you think Grandma felt when the Bunny family showed commitment to be there for her?

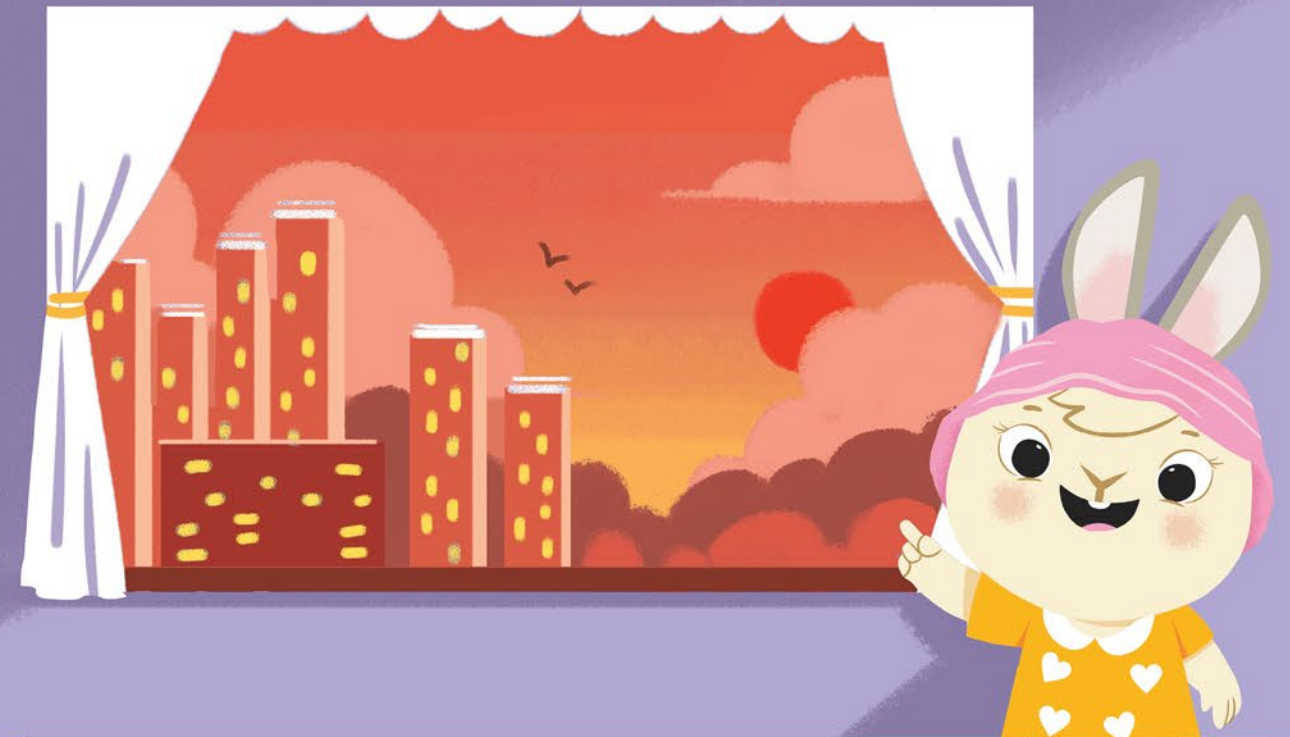


Becky Bunny wanted to help. She thought hard. "Grandma, did you go out today?" Becky Bunny asked.
