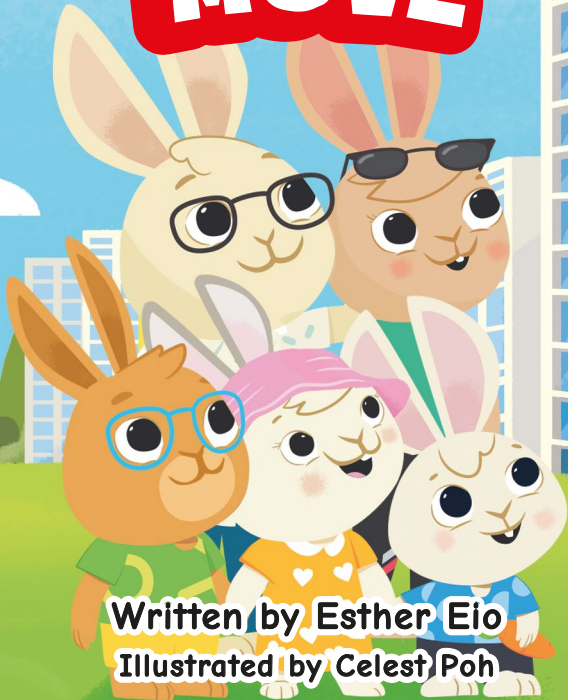


BECKY BUNNY'S ADVENTURES FOR LIFE
