Back home, Dad had lovingly prepared a scrapbook for them to paste their photos growing up in this house and neighbourhood.




The Bunny siblings' eyes lit up. They couldn't wait to see their new home.

Dad and Mum showed love to the Bunny siblings through small acts such as spending time together and giving thoughtful gifts. How do you show love to one another in your family?







Becky Bunny responded, "I don't have much space in my box, but let me try."


Becky Bunny took out a toy to fit Little Brother's train!


Becky Bunny showed love to Little Brother by sharing the space in her toy box. How can we learn to share in our family?

Dad said, "Everyone played an important part in this big move. I am glad we did things together as a family."








